The scientific session will start on Monday, 16th February

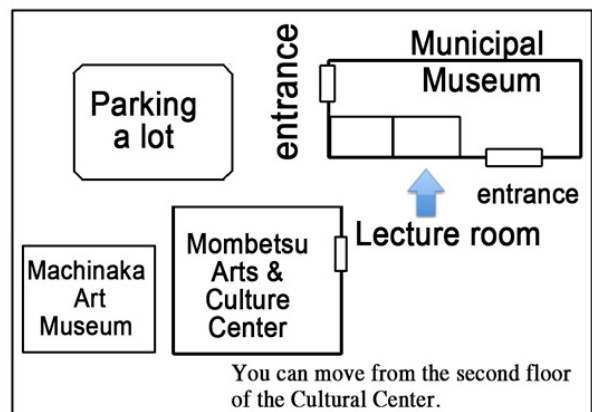
